From time to time, student work is shared through Artsonia, professional presentations, educational blogging (www.ArtisBasic.com), art lesson planning websites, school website and printed publications. Photos of students and full names are not posted online to protect privacy. The main source of communication to share art with families is **Artsonia and Thinkwave**.

Artsonia.com is an online student art gallery where parents and friends can view artwork, leave comments and purchase products with their child's artwork on it (such as mugs, t-shirts, notebooks). 20% of the sales are directly given to the art department to purchase more art supplies. After student artwork is submitted for the first time, you will receive a slip with your child's username and passcode. ***Artsonia now has a double layer of permissions and now they require parents to create an account before publicly showing any of the child's artwork on their website. So, you will need to create an account before you can see their work. ***
