




When have you seen numbers today?

Jasper Johns wanted us to look at their details and see them in a new way, as art! So, he made paintings of them.






Jasper did the same with other objects, such as maps and flags.

He decided he was going to use them in his paintings so that people could enjoy their shapes






That's just what he did. Everyday objects, especially things that are flat, like numbers and flags, became his subjects.
